



EuARe Travel Grants

Overview

The University of Vienna offers 50 travel bursaries of € 300 to partially cover conference expenses for early-career scholars.

Guidelines

The individual bursaries are **partial** and not intended to cover the full cost of attendance at the EuARe 2025 conference. They will cover only the registration fee for the conference, travel to the conference site, and accommodation costs. No other expenses or costs will be reimbursed. Reimbursement will occur only after the conference, upon submission of the original documents: a receipt of the registration fee and flight or train tickets. The bursary will cover expenses up to a maximum of \in 300. If the applicant's expenses are less than this amount, the bursary will be adjusted to the actual covered costs.

Conditions

- a) The applicant must be an **early career scholar** (this includes all scholars under the age of 35 (for men) and 40 (for women) and all graduate students independent of age)
- b) The applicant must be a member of EuARe
- c) The applicant must present a paper at the conference
- d) The applicant must have **sought funding from other sources** as well, such as the applicant's home university or national funding organizations
- e) Preference will be given to those who live in economically disadvantaged countries





Required Documents

- a) Title and abstract of the paper proposal (max. 150 words)
- b) CV (max. 2 pages)
- c) Motivation letter (max. 1 page)
- d) Letter of recommendation (1–2 pages)
- e) If the applicant is a student, they must also provide a **letter of support** from their academic **supervisor**, endorsing the quality of the application (max. 1 page)
- f) Proof of having sought funding from another source

Deadlines

- a) Please submit the required documents to euare 2025 @univie.ac.at, by April 4, 2025
- b) You will be notified of acceptance or decline by May 7, 2025
